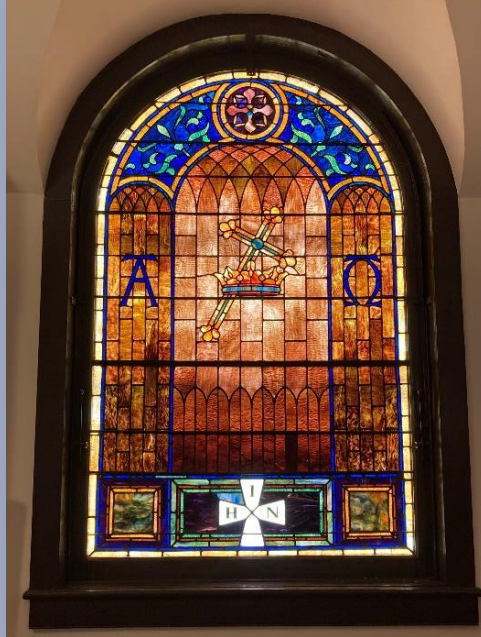

(In 1962, building expanded to left side.)

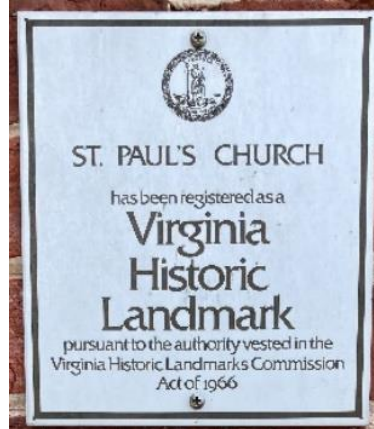


Rectory built 1900-05. Today, Church Office.

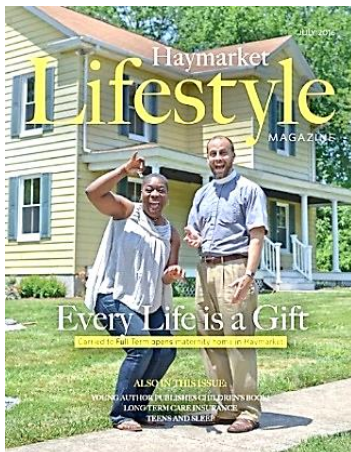
